

Southern Indiana Career & Technical Center Courses

What is the Southern Indiana Career & Technical Center?

The Center is a brand new, state-of-the-art facility offering specialized courses that are not available at MVHS. It is located on Lynch Rd. in Evansville, near the Evansville Regional Airport.

What classes can I take at the Career & Technical Center?

The following classes are available for MVHS students (full descriptions are available in the back of the MVHS Curriculum Guide):

- Automotive Collision Repair
- Automotive Services
- Building Trades
- Computer Network Technology (CISCO)
- Culinary Arts
- Diesel Service
- Electricity: Residential and Industrial
- Graphic Communications, Digital Media, & Printing Technology
- Health Sciences Education
- Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning, and Refrigeration
- Industrial Repair, Maintenance and Plastics
- Precision Machine Technology
- Public Safety/ Law Enforcement
- Radio/TV Broadcasting/Telecommunications
- Welding

How do the classes work, and how do I get there?

Students enrolled in courses at the Career & Technical Center attend class at the Center in the morning or afternoon (depending upon when the class is held), and attend classes at MVHS for the other part of the day. Students will be transported to and from the facility by school bus.

How many credits do I get for a course?

Most classes allow you to earn three (3) credits per semester. The credits will count as elective credit toward graduation for any high school diploma (General, Core 40, Academic Honors). Students in Health Sciences earn 2 elective credits and 1 credit in Anatomy & Physiology (a Core 40 science class) each semester in the first year.

If I complete an application, am I definitely accepted?

Not necessarily. The earlier you express interest, the better your chances of getting into the class you want. Accepted students are expected to stay in the course at least one semester.

What should I do if I am interested?

Come to the Counseling Office and sign up to attend the field trip to the Career & Technical Center, which will take place on Wednesday, January 20th! You will need to have a field trip permission form signed by a parent and returned by Tuesday, January 19th in order to attend the trip. Spaces are limited, so return your permission slips ASAP. Applications to classes must be completed and returned by Wednesday, January 27th for full consideration.
